

EBTP Teesheet Order of Flights Guidelines

When the Pro Shop creates the teesheet for a match, the goal is to create a flow so groups aren't stacking up on the teeboxes. Share the suggested "BAC" order with the Pro Shop to set up the order of play for each flight in a given pairing.

There are three assigned holes per pairing, one for each flight. The three flights should be kept together or back-to-back-to-back.

B Flight: first/ forward teebox

A Flight: second/ middle teebox

C Flight: third/ last teebox

Example: 3 separate teeboxes

<u>Order</u>	<u>Hole #</u>	<u>Start time</u>
B	7	8:30am
A	6	8:30am
C	5	8:30am

Example: 2 teeboxes (includes A & B grouping)

<u>Order</u>	<u>Hole #</u>	<u>Start time</u>
B	2	8:30am
A	1A	8:30am
C	1B	8:40am

Captain's Flight

When a Club offers a Captain's Flight, these players should be placed where their group won't hold up any of the competition. (either in front of or behind the "BAC" pairings)
