Minutes of East Bay Team Play Fall Meeting September 29, 2021 Oakhurst Country Club

Welcome and Introductions

The meeting was called to order by Sue Howell and Ann Brady, 2021 EBTP Directors, at 9:30 AM.

Catherine Clinehens of Green Valley presented an overview of EBTP Operations including paperwork processes and forms. Helpful documents were distributed outlining Host Club Responsibilities, Check-In Procedures for Captains and Hosting Club and Captain's Score sheet and Posting Scores. The Invitation sheet was reviewed with important required information highlighted. The index used for players will be as of the 1st of the month unless the match is in the first ten days of the month, in which case the index is the 15th of the prior month. The group approved the new streamlined line up sheet process for each club on the day of Team Play. Bring only two copies. One copy is handed to the Host Club at check-in which will be given to your opponent and the other copy is retained by your Team.

There was a discussion about the importance of checking your Pro Shop's work on the scorecards in advance of the match at your Club. There was a suggestion to use an excel spreadsheet to help.

A question arose about the shotgun start and it was agreed that teams should wait for the shotgun to start instead of going early. This will help avoid groups running into each other at the start. It was suggested that the Spring 2022 meeting include education of team members so Richmond will build this into the agenda.

Team shirts were discussed and the requirement for Teams to wear similar shirts that look like a team shirt.

The EBTP website is operational but will change due to Google changes. The clubs will be advised when the new version is available.

Rule Changes for 2022: Richmond will poll the clubs for rules issues they wish to discuss at the Spring Meeting.
